

Organize a Volunteer Event Crafting for a Cause – StoryBlocks



StoryBlocks is one of our most popular corporate volunteer events. Groups gather to assemble sets of wooden blocks depicting educational characters and letters. Tandem provides the raw materials and assembly instructions—you supply the willing participants! We can come to your office, or you can come to ours.

StoryBlocks are used by Tandem educators to reinforce storytelling and literacy skills through creative play in the classroom. They are also provided to parents attending our training workshops to learn how important language, talk, and play is for their child's early brain development.

We usually book groups for 2-3 hours, and have had some great feedback about the activity from volunteers at companies like Wells Fargo, Yelp, Salesforce, and Credit Suisse. We ask for a contribution of \$50 per person to cover the costs of materials—often this is covered by the company which requests the volunteer opportunity providing a corporate grant or other corporate contribution, and sometimes for larger groups we can get this cost lowered.
